





Health Care Foundation Grant's for CNA Certification and Recertification

The Health Care Foundation, in partnership with belairdirect, is pleased to support nursing excellence through its grant program for Canadian Nursing Association (CNA) certification and recertification. Funds are available to nurses employed with NL Health Services, Eastern Zone, with a focus on adult hospitals and health care centres in the St. John's vicinity.

- a. Applicants must be a permanent employee or a temporary / casual employee with a minimum of two years' service to NL Health Services, Eastern Zone.
- b. Applicants must be enrolled in or accepted to CNA certification or recertification.
- c. Grants will be awarded on a first come, first served basis.
- d. All successful applicants will agree to have their name released to CNA by the Health Care Foundation.
- e. A minimum of one year return of service is required in the specific area of educational preparation.
- f. Funding will be provided upon submission of CNA certification and recertification documentation to the Health Care Foundation via mail or email.

Application Process

Applications must be submitted to the Health Care Foundation by March 11, 2024. Late or incomplete submissions will not be considered.

- a. Applications for the grants must be submitted on the application form available through the Health Care Foundation.
- b. Applications must be accompanied by a letter explaining how this grant will benefit you to the Grant Selection Committee. Letter to be no longer than one page.
- c. Approval of grants will be issued by March 31, 2024.
- d. Funds will be dispersed upon submission of acceptance documentation to the CNA certification or recertification program.
- e. The decision of the *Grant Selection Committee* is final and confidential. If the recipient of the grant is unable to complete the program for which the funding was granted, the committee reserves the right to terminate payment or require repayment of the grant monies.
